TARGET AUDIENCE: Algebra I/Integrated I Teachers

Focus: The State of Tennessee has provided various paths for qualified middle school teachers to teach Algebra I/Integrated Math I for high school credit. The various paths are described at <https://www.tn.gov/education/licensing/educator-licensure/licensed-educators.html>. The purpose of the training option is to provide the pedagogical and content support as defined by the state training standards in a manner that meets the time frame and purposes of the teacher participant. During the academic year 2023-2024, there is an online version of the training available this summer. This training will require participation (with video camera on a computer) in live webinars for five evenings as well as the completion of independent mathematical work online.

Dates for webinar sessions: 6 – 9 pm CDT June 12-14 (MTW) and June 19-20, 2023 (MT).

Dates for independent work: June 12 – August 18, 2023.

The deadline for submitting the registration form and check is **two weeks before training is to begin: May 29, 2023**

**This summer session is available based upon sufficient enrollment. Ten or more participants are required for the training to be offered.*
